



## “JESUS, I TRUST YOU!”

On April 30, 2000, Pope John Paul II canonized the first saint of the new millennium: Sister Faustina Kowalski (d. 1935) through whom the **Divine Mercy Devotion** was given to the Church. On that same date the Pope declared that henceforth each year the first Sunday after Easter would be celebrated as **Divine Mercy Sunday**. In 2005, just after having celebrated the Vigil Mass Divine Mercy Sunday, Pope John Paul II died. St. Faustina’s feast day will be this Saturday (Oct. 5).
